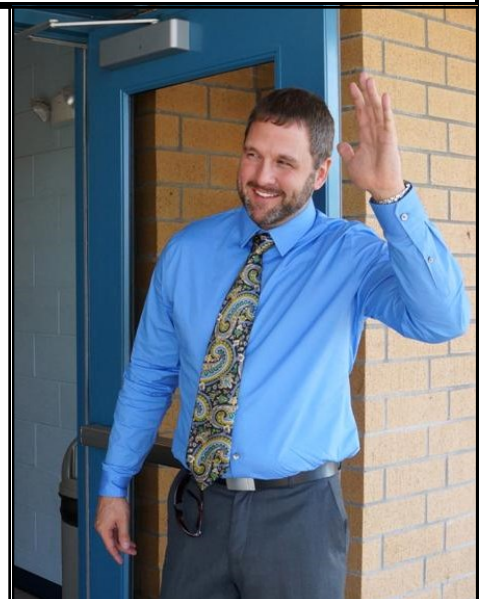
## ***New Administrative Assistant***

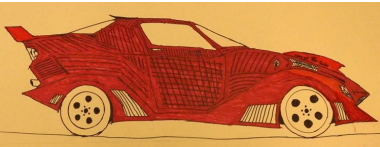
### **Box Top/Label for Education**
